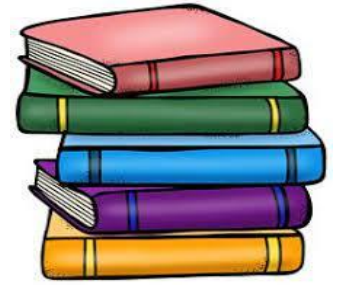


Welcome to the St. Mary of the Hill

SUMMER READING PROGRAM!

CHILD - Pre K through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade



Beginning June 13 you can check out up to 5 books per week.

Books for students are located in the Children's Room across from the Resource Center.

To check out a book:

1. Select an age appropriate book
  - a. Easy Reader - 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> Grader on their own and Pre -K
  - b. Picture Books - Great for children to read with parents or on their own
  - c. Chapter Books - 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade
2. Pull out the out the card at the back of the book
3. Fill it out card with (your) child's name
4. Place the card in Checkout Container\*

Keep track of the books you read to your child or your child reads to you. Tracking sheets are available next to the Checkout Container\*.

The next time you come to the parish center:

1. Find your child's Reading Log\*
2. Mark the number of books your child has read or you have read to your child on your child's reading log.
3. Place a sticker on a circle for each book read.
4. Return your books in bin marked Book Return\* and repeat the process.

For every 5 books read, your child's name will be entered into a drawing for a prize. If it is a chapter book for 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> graders, every 20 pages counts as a book. There will be 4 drawings throughout the summer. If your child's name is selected in the drawing, you will be notified via a phone call.
