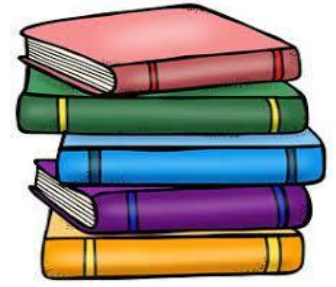


# Welcome to the St. Mary of the Hill SUMMER READING PROGRAM!

## YOUTH - 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Grade



Beginning June 13 you can check out up to **3** books per week.

Books for students are located in the Resources Center.

To check out a book: Select a book

1. Select an age appropriate book.  
**Please note that while we have chosen Catholic books for the youth age group, parents are responsible for checking the content of the books to make sure the content is age appropriate for their teen.**
2. If there is a card in back, pull out the out the card.
3. Fill it out card with your name.
4. Place the card in Checkout Container\*

Keep track of the number of pages you read.

Once you have completed a book the next time you come to the parish center:

1. Find your Reading Log\*
2. Record the name of the book you are reading and number of pages you have read.
3. Return your book in bin marked Book Return\* and repeat the process.

For every **50** pages read rounded up (i.e. 70 pages will count as 2 points), you will receive a point. Every **5** points (250 pages) your name will be entered into a drawing for a prize. There will be 4 drawings throughout the summer. If your name is selected in the drawing, you will be notified via a phone call.
