	Examples: Help at a soup kitchen; volunteer at a	
	bake sale; help at a food pantry; bring a meal to	
	someone who needs it; take a friend out for lunch;	
	donate baby formula, food, or supplies to a	
	pregnancy help clinic.	
	Clothe the Naked	
	Examples: Dontate or organize a donation drive for	
	clothing/other items; make blankets for homeless,	
	babies, elderly, or for a parish fundraiser etc; help	
	to sort donated clothes at Fr. Geene's Help Center,	
	do laundry for your family.	
	Visit the Imprisoned (includes helping those not as	
	free with their time ie homebound or mother of	
	young kids)	
	Examples: Make rosaries for prison ministry; pray	
	for the imprisoned & their families, help with	
	homebound visits in the parish; offer to babysit for	
	a mother of all young children; offer to babysit a	
	younger sibling for your mom.	
	Visit the Sick	
	Care for a sick/disabled/struggling family member	
	or friend; send flowers or a card to someone in the	
	hospital, visit a nursing home/volunteer to help at	
	Christmas, with games or more; do yardwork, pick	
	up groceries, bring a meal, or visit with an elderly	
	or homebound neighbor.	
	Shelter the Homeless (or homebound)	
	Donate to a homeless shelter, volunteer labor for	
	upkeep at a homeless shelter; help homeless or	
	underprivileged children with classwork or	
	childcare; help an elderly neighbor with home	
	repairs.

	Examples: Attend wakes and/or funerals of those	
	you knew; volunteer with a hospice program;
